N-RELEASE is a controlled release foliar fertilizer that provides weeks of stable nutrition with a single application. Based on controlled release nitrogen technology, N-RELEASE is safe and economical to use, providing a safe and balanced source of nitrogen for many weeks. N-RELEASE is an excellent supplement to any fertilization program, providing a nitrogen supplement at the right time for a better turf vigor and quality, without causing nitrogen saturation as conventional fertilizers.

Because of its controlled release action for several weeks, it does not cause nitrogen saturation, making it safe for use. N-RELEASE is completely miscible with most pesticide mixtures, and is an excellent option to correct and maintain optimal nitrogen levels in times of excess or lack of water, at times of higher requirements, or in conditions of difficulty of N levels in the soil.

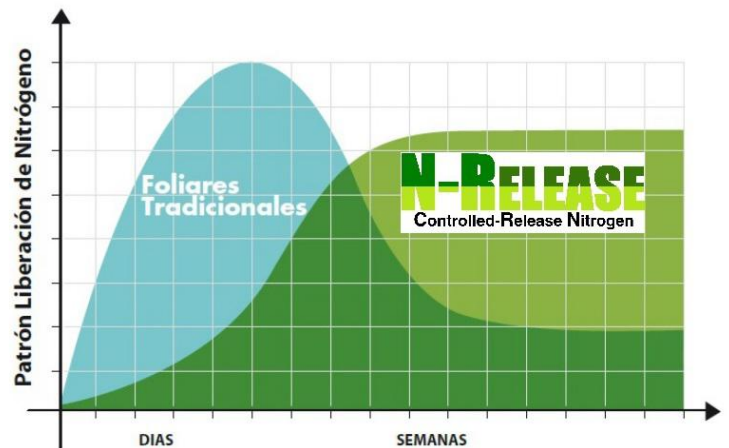
N-RELEASE 25-0-0 +0.5% Boron:
Controlled-release nitrogen for up to seven weeks plus boron. **25.0% Nitrogen (N)**, 70% immediately available (urea, ammoniacal and nitrate) and 30% of controlled-release N (triazone), **0.5% Boron (B)**.

N-RELEASE 25-0-0 + MICRO-NUTRIENTS:
Controlled-release nitrogen for up to seven weeks plus six micro-nutrients. **25.0% Nitrogen (N)**, 70% immediately available (urea, ammoniac and nitrate) and 30% of controlled-release N (triazone), plus six micronutrients:

0.5% Boron (B) 0.05% Copper (Cu)
0.1% Iron (Fe) 0.05% Manganese (Mn)
0.05% Zinc (Zn) 0.05% Molybdenum (Mo)

N-RELEASE 28-0-0: Controlled-release nitrogen for up to 14 weeks..

28.0% Nitrogen (N): 30% immediately available (ureic, ammoniac and nitrate) and 70% of controlled-release N (triazone).
